Boadicea is a dwarf variety and was bred as a general purpose variety with moderate alpha and good flavor. It has a mellow citrus flavor with a light flowery aroma and faint lime-like aroma. Boadicea is derived from an open pollination of a second-generation female from a wild Japanese hop.
