Dual Purpose Hop

Bor, which means pine, was registered as a dual purpose variety in 1994 and was named after the pinewoods which are typical for a region in the Czech Republic. It was derived from Northern Brewer. It is resistant to downy mildew but somewhat susceptible to powdery mildew.
