Aroma Hop



Originating from the Saaz hop, this variety has very fine aroma characteristics. Today Lublin is cultivated in the Polish growing regions Lublin, Poznan and Opole. It is average in alpha and hectare yield, however, its agronomic performance is better than that of Saaz. Lublin has a good tolerance to diseases and grows on light to medium heavy soils.
