



# Premiant

Czech Rep  
Aroma Hop

Premiant is a Czech dual purpose hop variety selected from hybrid progenies of the Saaz variety and other breeding material. It was registered in 1996 and has a relatively high alpha acid content and a good agronomic yield. Premiant has a mild and pleasant aroma.
