High Alpha Hop

The Australian Super Pride is a seedless high alpha acid variety, bred by the Hop Products Australia Rostrevor breeding program. Bred from the famous Pride of Ringwood, it has been Australia's dominant hop variety since the 1960s. This cultivar was bred by crossing a female tetraploid Pride of Ringwood with a male YK-81-18, and features mild aroma and low cohumulone.
