



Topaz

Australia
Dual Purpose Hop

Topaz was originally selected as a seedless high alpha hop, but recent work has shown it to have excellent flavor potential. Topaz can provide earthy notes similar in character to old English cultivars, and fruit flavors including lychee can be detected from late-hop additions and higher gravity brews.
