Rakau™ is a triploid variety that was developed by the New Zealand Plant & Food Hop Research Centre. When first released in 1983 the cultivar was known as AlphaAroma. It was re-released in 2007 as Rakau. The hop is described as having unique fruit flavors with strong stone fruit character.
