Aroma Hop

Sybilla is a Polish hop derived from a cross of Lubelski and Slovenian Styrian Golding. It was released in 1996 and in the years 2004-2006, hop latent viroid free seedlings of Sybilla were produced.

Farnesene	6 - 9 % of total oil
