Aroma Hop

Sylva is a fine aroma hop developed in Australia as a seedless alternative to the famous Saaz cultivar. The flavor imparted to beer by Sylva is very close in character to Saaz. Its aroma is typically refined, with spicy and herbal hop characters predominant. Sylva is an alternative to Saaz from the southern hemisphere and offers a noble-type aroma.
