

HBC 630 c.v.

HBC 630 c.v. is an experimental hop cultivar developed by the Hop Breeding Company (HBC). It was bred from a 2008 cross between two experimental hop varieties.

HBC 630 c.v. is complex and fruity, with sweet fruit (cherry) and berry (raspberry) character. In addition, sweet candy-like esters and lactones combine to give creamy notes of banana and peaches.
