



## AROMA PROFILE

Developed at the Hop Research Center in Huell, and formerly named 2010/008/033 during trials. This high beta-acids hop variety is derived from German hop material from the famous Tradition variety. Callista has many meanings, but mostly it is referred to as a meaning “most beautiful (feminine)” in Greek.
